

Directions from Sheltopee Trace Outfitters (STO)

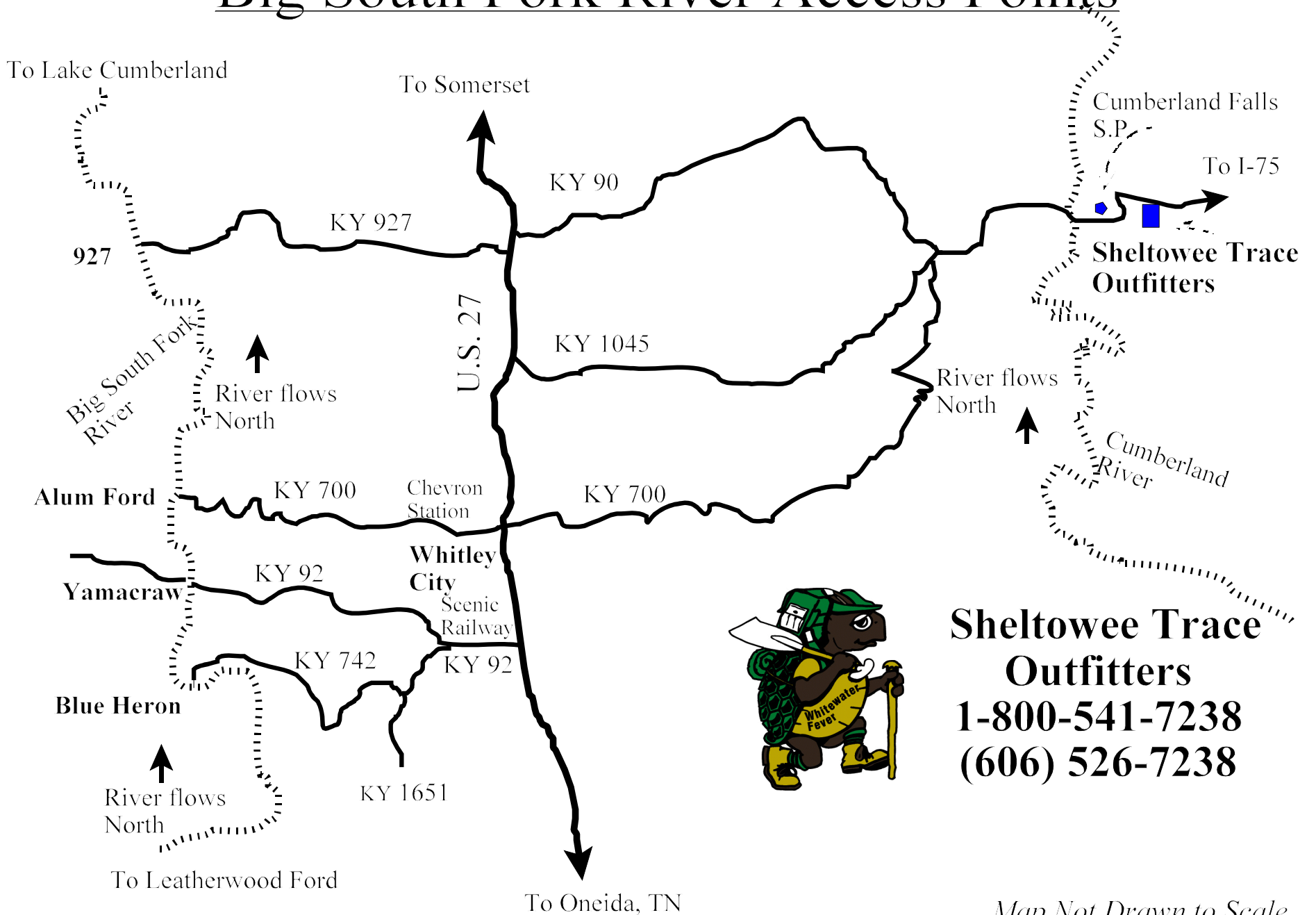
Directions to Blue Heron: Turn left out of the STO parking lot onto Hwy 90. Follow Hwy 90 for 7.5 miles. Turn left onto Hwy. 1045/700, and follow the right hand fork to stay on 1045. Follow 1045 for 7.5 Miles to where it T's onto U.S. 27. Turn left onto U.S. 27 South. Follow U.S. 27 for 7.7 miles through Whitley City to a stoplight intersection with Hwy 92. There is also a sign for the Big South Fork Scenic Railroad. Turn right. Follow Hwy 92 for 1.3 miles. You will pass the Big South Fork Scenic Railway on the left. Just past this the road forks. There is a sign that says Blue Heron to the left, Yamacraw to the right. Take the left hand fork. Follow this road for 1.1 Miles. You should see a sign for Blue Heron just before you go over a small bridge. Turn right. This will put you on KY 742. Follow this road the rest of the way to Blue Heron (10.3 Miles). Continue past the railroad station, until you get to the very very last parking lot. The gravel trail at the end of the parking lot is the river access. Approximate driving time: 45-60 minutes.

Directions to Yamacraw: Turn left out of the STO parking lot onto Hwy 90. Follow Hwy 90 for 7.5 miles. Turn left onto Hwy. 1045/700, and follow the right hand fork to stay on 1045. Follow 1045 for 10 Miles to where it T's onto U.S. 27. Turn left onto U.S. 27 South. Follow U.S. 27 through Whitley City for 7.7 Miles to a stoplight intersection with Hwy 92. There is also a sign for the Big South Fork Scenic Railroad. Turn right. Follow Hwy 92 for 1.3 Miles. You will pass the Big South Fork Scenic Railway on the right. Just past this the road forks. There is a sign that says Blue Heron to the left, Yamacraw to the right. Take the right hand fork. Follow this road for 5.4 Miles. You will go over a fairly high bridge over the Big South Fork river. Immediately past this bridge is a road to the left. Turn left here. Immediately after turning left, there will be a gravel road to the left that looks like it drops over the side of the hill. Turn onto this gravel road. It leads to the river access area. Caution: If your vehicle has very low clearance, or trouble making it up hills, you may wish to inspect the road on foot first. Approximate driving time: 45-60 minutes.

Directions to Alum Ford: Turn left out of the STO parking lot onto Hwy 90. Follow Hwy 90 for 7.5 miles. Turn left onto Hwy. 1045/700, and follow the right hand fork to stay on 1045. Follow 1045 for 7.5 Miles to where it T's onto U.S. 27. Turn left onto U.S. 27 South. Follow U.S. 27 for 4.4 Miles. As you start to come into Whitley City city, you should see a Chevron Station on the right. Turn right just past the Chevron Station onto Hwy 700. Follow 700. In ½ mile, you will go over a railroad track and up a little hill where 700 intersects with another road. Make sure that you go straight across the intersection. Follow 700 another 5.1 Miles to where it reaches the water. Caution: At high lake levels (Spring), the parking lot and part of the road leading to it is covered with water. **Do not drive into the water.** Approximate driving time: 45 minutes.

Directions to 927: Turn left out of the STO parking lot onto Hwy 90. Follow Hwy 90 for 18.6 miles to where it T's onto U.S. 27. Turn left onto U.S. 27 South. Go 0.6 Miles, and turn right onto Hwy 927. Follow Hwy 927 9.1 Miles to where it reaches the water. Caution: At high lake levels (Spring), the lower parking lot and part of the road leading to it is covered with water. **Do not drive into the water.** Approximate driving time: 45 minutes.
